___ If applicable, let your child(ren) know about the seal coating and let them know that they need to keep off the street?

___ Determine if you will need to use your vehicle on the date your street is closed? (Do not drive on treated streets for 12 hours. The seal coat will track onto concrete and non-treated surfaces.)

___ Made plans to park your vehicle in an unaffected alternate area the date your street is closed?

___ Parked any extra vehicles away from the street and closer to your garage or move them to an unaffected area for the day your street is closed?

___ Cleared the street of any personal items such as vehicles, trash cans, grass clippings, activity equipment, boxes, bags?

___ Turned OFF sprinklers, the day before your streets road treatment takes place? Systems can be turned back on when the road opens to traffic.

___ Are you impacted on a Trash or Recycling Day? Place toters/cans out the night before. Items will be collected between 6:00 and 7:00am that morning. No bulk items or yard debris will be collected.
